

- The objective of the CSHA is the encouragement, regulation and development of the breeding of the Canadian Sport Horse in Canada from an evolving breed to a distinct breed.
- The Canadian Sport Horse Association dates back to 1926. The Canadian Hunter and Light Horse Improvement Society was created which later evolved into the Canadian Hunter Improvement Society, later renamed the Canadian Sport Horse Association in the mid 1980's
- The CSHA is incorporated under Agriculture Canada's Animal Pedigree Act as an Evolving Breed
- As of 2020, the CSHA has also included the recording of the Canadian Sport Pony as a separate strain within the Sport Horse Book.
- CSHA is gearing up to celebrate our 100th year Anniversary and we want to hear from our members – how do you want to celebrate with us?

Your horse's papers are its birth certificate. They state when and where the horse was born, who its parents are, its colour and gender. Where a set of papers are issued does not sell your horse, its bloodlines do, and the horse does. So, support breeding in Canada and register your horses with a Canadian studbook!

The genesis of the symposium series came from brainstorming ways to celebrate the upcoming centenary of the CSH studbook in 2026. The Board decided that a showcase of our Canadian-bred horses would highlight the exceptional passion and investment that goes into breeding performance horses and would showcase the top-quality breeding we have here in the province.

We decided on a symposium series that would highlight the development and production of our young horses from beginning jumper all the way to Grand Prix.

We have been so fortunate in our clinicians; they are all top in their field of show jumping. All have represented their country in Nations Cups or Olympics, and all have so much knowledge to share.

This year's clinician, Andrew Bourns, may not be a household name – yet. But he has so much expertise to share on developing good horses and making them great. ## MEET —ANDREW BOURNS



2024 Masterclass Instructor



Andrew Bourns was born and raised in Galway, Ireland where he began riding at just 3 years old. A natural talent was apparent from the beginning leading to many successes in the pony and junior ranks throughout his home country and in Europe. Some of these early accomplishments include representing Team Ireland at European Pony Championships, European Junior Championships and European Young Rider Championships where he helped Ireland secure a Team Silver Medal and brought home Individual Bronze.

During these early career successes, it became evident that Andrew had a gift for taking good horses and making them great.

This led him down the path of developing horses for the sport of show jumping and the formation of what is now Andrew Bourns Sport Horses, Inc. Andrew his has spent most of focusing professional career on sourcing and producing horses Roundthorn

Madios, Christobar, Benny's Legacy, Gatsby, Caspar, Diego, MHS Attraction and CHS Inception to name a few which have taken him and the world's top riders up to the CSI5\* Grand Prix Level including Nations Cups and World Championships. Today, Andrew is recognized as one of the leading producers of world-class Show Jumpers. Equally as accomplished in the ring, Andrew has accumulated many of his own successes as a competition rider including his most recent Top Placings in the 2023 \$1M CSIO5\* Queen's Cup at Spruce Meadows and the 2022 CSIO5\* Dublin Horse Show Grand Prix.

Throughout his riding career, Andrew has made regular appearances on the Irish Nations Cup Teams and has led Ireland to several victories including the 2022 CSIO5\* Nations Cup wins at both Thunderbird and Wellington with his current mount, 13 Yr Old Irish Sport Horse, Sea Topblue. In August of 2022, the pair were selected to represent Ireland at the CSIO5\* Nations Cup Finals in Barcelona and have also secured wins and top placings in several Grand Prix's at the CSI4\* and CSI5\* levels across the U.S, Canada and Europe. Andrew Bourns is also a decorated coach and has helped his students reach success from the U25 through the CSI5\* levels. Andrew's students have earned many wins in High Junior and Amateur divisions, U25 and International divisions and Gold, Silver and Bronze medal placings

at Junior and Young Rider finals. Some of Andrew's proudest career moments have been developing riders to the top of the sport and watching as his students step into professional careers of their own. Andrew's coaching program consists of an immersive, hands on approach with structured, strategic goal setting and career planning. He holds his students to the highest level of horsemanship and hopes to continue inspiring the next generation of professionals.




She has been on Billy Jean for a short 3 weeks and is enjoying this mare's aptitude for jumping.



## **Developing Jumper**



Pia has been riding and "growing up in the barn" since she could walk and has joined Pony Club and 4-H. She chased cows with her brother, did extensively trail riding in the Rockies and focused her ambitions on Dressage riding since she was a teenager.

She trained for 5 years with Leslie Reid while going to Simon Fraser University getting a Bachelor in Psychology, went to NAJYR Championships winning Team Gold and Individual Gold, trained for 9 years in Germany where she got the chance to ride her first CDI Grand Prix with Orion at Aachen and Wiesbaden and never looked back training and teaching high level dressage successfully.

Lindsay is a professional rider of 18 years, having developed countless horses up to and including National Grand Prix level, as well as young riders through an equitation approach to 1.40m, National Medal Finals and FEI Childrens Finals and nation cup teams.

Vesuvio is a 6 year old stallion owned by his breeder Rob Kerr out of Manitoba. Vesuvio was an exceptionally talented 5 year old showcasing skill in both the hunter and jumper rings last year, doing everything that was asked of him willingly and skillfully.

Vesuvio stepped out of the show ring for the winter to allow his young body to develop more and has just returned to the show ring for the 2024 outdoor season. Due to his beautiful technique, lovely rideability, and with longevity in sport in mind, breeder and rider have opted to develop him in a slower approach in both hunters and jumpers, before they intend to see his scope and talent through in the bigger jumpers.

## Developing Jumper



Professional rider, but also a breeder of warmbloods. I have done some 1.45m (a long time ish ago). And now just train and sell (usually young) warmbloods for primarily hunter/jumpers. I'd love to get one we have bred into the 1.45m rings.

Carmina Burana NF is behind most 6 year olds. Between my injuries and her many injuries she has only been to 3 shows. She doesn't move properly behind, and that's because she completely severed a tendon and partially severed another tendon in her right hind leg at 2 years old.

She's a Chacoon Blue x Acord II x Grannus mare, did move up to the 1.00m at March Spruce this year easily. But hasn't schooled higher. We bred her so I've been her rider since the very beginning. It would be nice if we can get her up to the 1.20ms at least.

Messi successfully showed in his age classes in both Canada and the US. As a 6-yearold he was overall Jump Canada 1.20m champion. He successfully competed at the Spruce Meadows Masters in 2023 with Olympic rider Francois Mathy Jr. Going into his 7-year-old year he is currently competing successfully at the 1.35m- 1.40m level.

Not only is he a talented show horse with all the scope and heart to be a winner, Messi is also a lovely breeding stallion. Producing top quality offspring for the sport of show jumping. He stamps his offspring with his beautiful looks and excellent character.

Shaelynn Enders is 26 years old. She is a trainer and rider at Sweet Talk Stables. Shaelynn recently completed he diploma in Equine Studies, while riding and training full time. Shaelynn enjoys developing horses, one of her biggest accomplishments is developing her once problematic 4-year-old Warmblood to a 1.35/40 Grand Prix winner.

Shae is new to riding Messi AO but has watched her sister ride him the last couple years and is excited for the opportunity to step in for a little.

She plans to continue this year in the 1.30/40's with Messi as well as showing some young horses.
